JOB DESCRIPTION

The New Jersey Department of the Treasury's and its In-But-Not-Of Agencies are currently accepting applications for internship opportunities. The internship opportunities aim to provide highly motivated undergraduate, graduate, doctoral, or law students with compensated hands-on training and work experience. Participating divisions will offer special projects and assignments designed to prepare students for their future careers.

The Division of Risk Management serves the Judiciary, Executive, and Legislative branches of the New Jersey State government by providing active leadership in reducing risk and the loss to persons and property; ensuring cost-effective administration of claims filed against the State of New Jersey, its departments, and agencies, while maintaining the highest ethical standards in the claims management industry; investigating and adjusting claims made against the State or on behalf of the State, stemming from accidents or incidents involving property damage and bodily injury; and managing the State Accident Review Board, and the Statewide Defensive Driving Course Program.

The intern will report to and work closely with the Deputy Director on a number of statewide initiatives and Division-wide projects. This includes, but is not limited to, the ongoing cloud-based Claims Management system to streamline the claims filing and handling process, for the benefit of our State client agencies, the general public, attorneys, and the State as a whole; assist the Deputy Director and the New Jersey State Police in preparing cases for review, debate, and voting before the inter-agency State Accident Review Board ("ARB"); and managing the Statewide Vehicle Accident Reporting System and the Statewide Defensive Driving Program.
